Navigating Louisiana's NEW Closed Party Primaries

The Louisiana Legislature* now requires closed party primaries for certain contests, ensuring that only registered party members (and unaffiliated voters) can vote in choosing their party's candidates.



eep your registration current!

Your official party registration determines which party primary you vote in. You can verify or update your registration at GeauxVote.com, the GeauxVote app, or in person.



ot everyone will vote on every contest!

Democrats will vote for Democratic candidates, Republicans for Republican, and "No Party" (unaffiliated) voters may select either primary.



nly the following offices are part of the Closed Party Primary system:

The U.S. Senate and U.S. House (Congress), Louisiana Supreme Court, Public Service Commission (PSC), and Board of Elementary & Secondary Education (BESE). Other ballot contests will be open to all voters.

Registration and Affiliation Deadlines

First Party Primary: April 18, 2026



Last day to register or make changes to registration, including party affiliation:

In-person or by mail *March 18*, 2026 or online at GeauxVote.com through *March 28*, 2026

Party Primary Runoff: May 30, 2026



A runoff will occur if no candidate receives a majority of the votes. Voters stay with the party they voted for in the first party primary. New voters may register or make affiliation changes:

Deadline to register or make changes: In-person or by mail by *April 29*, *2026* or online at GeauxVote.com through *May 9*, *2026*
